

COVID-19 Statement

After much fellowship and prayer the decision was made to conduct the Florida Truth School in person this summer at a camp in Summerfield, FL. Please be assured that your health and safety is one of our primary concerns in our consideration.

We will continue to monitor the situation and make updates to that plan as the conditions determine. For now we are working to do everything we can to be prepared and address your concerns.

We will:

- Disinfect common surfaces more frequently.
- Make hand sanitizers available at many locations.
- Have on site medical care to address your medical concerns.
- Have Vitamins C, D and Zinc available.

We ask you to:

- Wash your hands often, but especially after bathroom use
- Provide yourself with disinfecting wipes and/or hand sanitizer
- Be extra mindful of fellow young people and serving ones to keep the area around your bunk clean
- After eating, take all of your garbage to the garbage cans
- Be mindful of others by social distancing when possible

We are doing our best to align with local, state, federal and global public health guidelines and agencies. This includes promoting handwashing and healthy hygiene practices among our young people and serving ones. The camp does not mandate mask wearing and therefore, we are also not requiring anyone to wear a mask. However, we encourage you to allow the peace of Christ to arbitrate in your hearts when considering which precautions you and your young people should take when attending truth school.
